One of the most educational aspects of the whole experience was learning Reza's RMCG backstory. I'm referring of course to the Reza/Gilardino/Viplav Italian affair.

Such an affair never existed. Mr Reza Ganjavi contacted me as a guitar player who was interested to my music. Viplav is the name of a young guitar student (whose surname I do not feel authorized to quote here) who attended a Summercourse I gave in Italy on 2000. The two connections developed separately. Whether Reza and Viplav had a contact or not, it happened independently from any connection with me. Incidentally, none of the two contacts with me was extraordinary, so as to deserve the label of "affair": they were two professional contacts happened in terms of courtesy: nothing to be especially recalled or complained.

Considering Reza's intimate relationship with Angelo Gilardino, it was not surprising to see the maestro's name appear in Reza's suit. In the original complaint, filed December 2005, he repeatedly refers to one of his CDs as a "best seller". In support of this assertion, he teases us as follows:

"Exhibit 6 is one testimony to the success of his CD, 'In Friendship', by a very credible source."

What is Exhibit 6, you ask? Why, it's a statement from AG himself:

Again, this is sheer fantasy. The relationship I had with Mr Ganjavi was a professional one, approached and continued friendly, yes - at it happens with most of my job connections - but whose contents were strictly those of my commitment as a composer and his interest for my music. There is no need of being in intimate terms with a person in order to release a statement as the one I wrote: it is a simple, civil declaration of facts of which I had been a part, and it would have been - at my eyes at least - uncorrect and unfair to refuse to give a witness of them. Whether, how much and how effectively it was used, it is not a point to me: I felt I had payed my duties with writing it, and I have no interest to know what it worked for.
